An Information Based Model of Consciousness Fully Explaining the Mind Normal/Paranormal Properties

ABSTRACT

The main informational components of consciousness are described as Operative Informational System (OIS) assuring the reactive short-time adaptation and Programmed Informational System (PIS), assuring the life maintenance and the species survival, working in an integrated manner with the informed matter IM (body). The defined informational subsystems allow to describe consciousness as a sum of cognition centers defined by *Isosens*, *Isosens*, *Isosens*, *Isosens*, *Isosens*, *Isosens*, *Isosens* and *Isosens*. 1. Introduction
